Emanuel, in conjunction with Trinity Episcopal Church, will be offering Financial Peace University beginning on September 12th and running for 9 weeks.

Emanuel Lutheran will be working with Hartford Area Habitat for Humanity and Thrivent Financial on a "Building on Faith" event that will be taking place on September 29th.

The current plan is to work on 3 or 4 houses (it depends on what the city will permit) on the same parcel on land on Main Street in Hartford.

- 16 is the minimum age for volunteers to join us on site, 18 is the minimum age to use power tools.
- 5 is the minimum number of Volunteers required to build. 12 is the maximum number of volunteers per house.
- The deadline to register is Monday, Sept. 24th at mid-night. We then can give our construction director the number of volunteers so he can plan on how many crew leaders he'll need.

AMMPARO, ADVOCACY AND ACCOMPANIMENT WORKSHOP

A Workshop Event of the New England Synod's World Hunger Team and The Refugee & Immigration Task Force will be held on Sunday, October 14, 2018 from 1:30 pm to 6:30 pm at Emanuel Lutheran Church.

The ELCA's strategy to Accompanying Migrant Minors with Protection, Advocacy, Representation and Opportunities (AMMPARO) was envisioned after witnessing the plight of children who are forced to flee their communities because of complex and interrelated reasons, including chronic violence, poverty, environmental displacement and lack of opportunities in El Salvador, Honduras and Guatemala.

Mary Campbell, Director of AMMPARO, will be presenting information about AMMPARO and leading us in an experiential activity, migrating from Central America.

The cost is \$10, and the registration deadline is September 29. A light supper will be served.
