- Modeen letter must be no more than 2 single space pages, using a 12 pt. font that is easy to read.
- Applicants must carefully edit their letter. The scorers may deduct one point for significant grammatical errors, demonstrating that proofreading did not take place.
- One point will be deducted from the total score if the applicant does not spell "Emanuel Lutheran Church" correctly.
- An additional point will be given to the overall score to applicants who thank Mr. Modeen and/or the scholarship committee for their consideration and/or previous funding.

- Applicants must make sure to carefully document and explain the ten hours or more service time they give to the church as a volunteer. This is primarily volunteer work with Emanuel Lutheran Church. Although we encourage you to volunteer with nonprofits, fraternities/sororities, and other organizations, those hours **do not** count toward the tenhour minimum commitment you are making to Emanuel Lutheran Church. If you are unable to make the tenhour commitment to Emanuel Lutheran Church, alternative church volunteer work must be approved by Pastor Paula **in advance** in order for those hours to count.
- Pastor Paula's signature is required for sign-off of the ten service hours in order for your application to be considered
